Dear Triad School District Community,

I am writing to inform you that a student who attends Triad Middle School has tested positive for COVID-19. Due to privacy laws, we cannot disclose further information about the student. Whenever a person has a suspected or confirmed COVID-19 case, they must be quarantined per the CDC and local health department guidelines and may not return until they meet the CDC's criteria for returning to school. The student that tested positive attended school during the week of 11/9 -11/13 with some minor symptoms.

The local health department has been notified of this situation. The health department is very busy with the rise in cases and have asked us to do all contact tracing in the school. We will be doing that in the next several hours and calling all families that are impacted by this by 7pm tonight. Based on guidance from the health department and other agencies, classrooms that may have been exposed are getting an extra cleaning before school tomorrow. District employees and students should continue to follow CDC guidelines and recommendations, and should continue to practice social distancing and properly wear a mask (covering the nose) and remember not to come to school if they are showing any symptoms.

As a precaution, we encourage you to monitor your health, follow CDC guidelines, and contact your doctor if you develop COVID-19 symptoms.

The District is continuing to monitor this situation. We will provide additional information when permissible. The student is doing well but as always we appreciate you keeping them in your thoughts and prayers.
