Dear Triad Staff and Families:

The district continues to monitor the situation regarding COVID-19 (also known as coronavirus) and follow the guidance provided by our local and federal health officials. At this time, there are 14 confirmed cases of the Coronavirus in Ohio. Please remember that prevention is our best course of action. Continue to reinforce and practice the strategies for reducing the spread of this type of infection. (Wash hands, cover cough, avoid handshakes, keep your distance, stay home if you're sick)

Yesterday, Governor DeWine made the decision to close schools for the next three weeks (3/16-4/3). The Triad staff has been working hard to create a plan that will ensure education can continue while keeping everyone home and safe.

**Attendance and Communication:**

Teachers will communicate through email on a regular basis and will be available for emails and calls starting March 30th from 8am - 3pm.

**Pick up information:**

We are currently working on a plan for food distribution and will share updated information next week. If you are in need of food in the meantime, please see the information below:

Food Pantry: To address the needs for food during the school shutdown, the food pantry at the North Lewisburg United Methodist Church will be open on Wednesdays, March 18, 25 and April 1st, 5:00-7:00 PM. They will prepare bags of food items to share. The plan is to distribute the bags to people in their cars. Along with the food they offer...the Blessing Bags Ministry will provide food bags to families with children since they will not be able to receive them at school.

Thank you for being patient with us as we work to minimize the impact of Coronavirus on our students, their education and the community.
