

# DRINKING WATER NOTICE

## Monitoring requirements not met for TRIAD MIDDLE SCHOOL

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During the Fourth Quarter of 2019 time period we did not monitor for the following contaminants and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time:  
ARSENIC.

### What Should I Do?

This notice is to inform you that TRIAD MIDDLE SCHOOL did not monitor and report results for the presence of the contaminants listed above in the public drinking water system during the Fourth Quarter of 2019 time period, as required by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency. You do not need to take any actions in response to this notice.

### What Is Being Done?

Upon being notified of this violation, the water supply was required to have the drinking water analyzed for the above mentioned parameters. The water supplier will take steps to ensure that adequate monitoring will be performed in the future.
